

This application for a system ID number is only for the following:

- Spouses of Icelandic and EEA/EFTA citizens who are employed in Iceland but are awaiting the decision on a residence permit application at the Directorate of Immigration.
- Non-residents with taxable capital income in Iceland. The applicant is not required to sign the form, but a copy of passport or travel document must be attached.

A system ID number does not grant the applicant any rights in Iceland nor does it not confirm the right to residency in the country.
